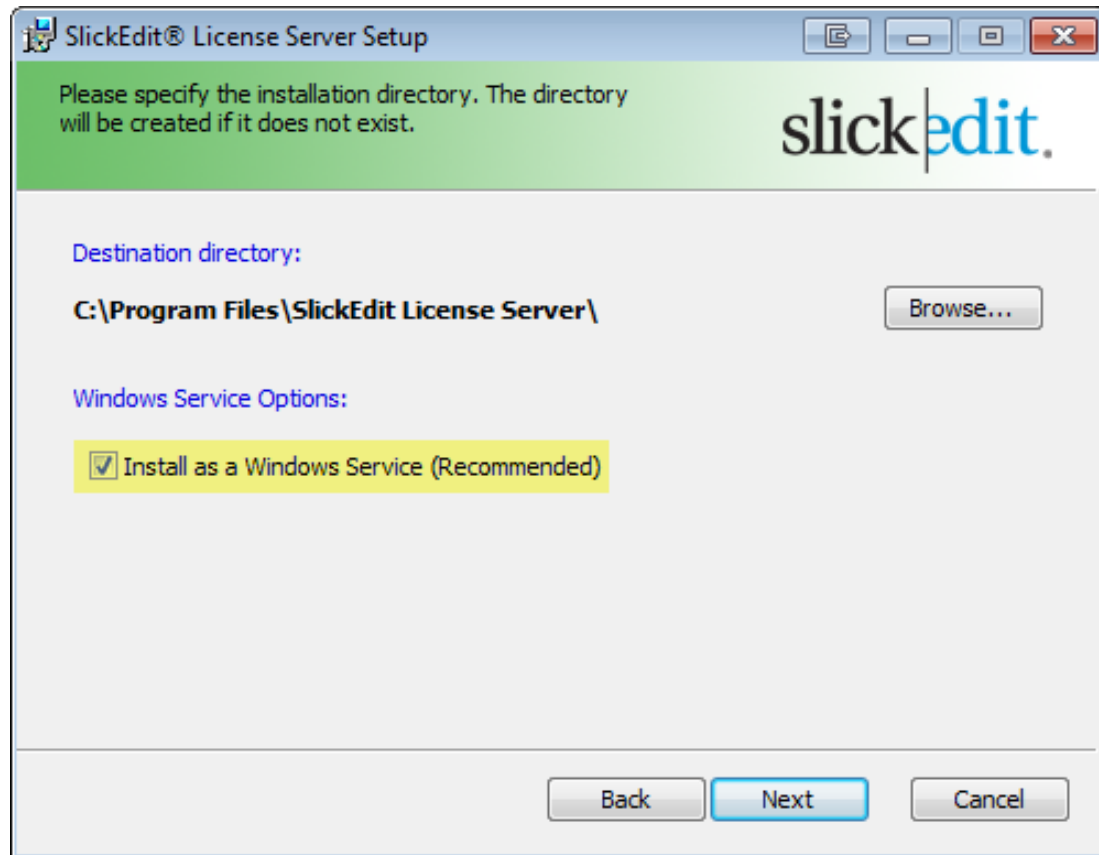

A: If you are willing to spend some time, you could start with DOM parser.
